

About the park

The Park opens to the public with the aim of publicizing the natural beauty, and promoting environmental education through tourism and scientific research. To achieve this it is important that the principles on which the park was created are respected. This fulfills a

function of respect for nature and us. The rules set out below do not play a role prohibitive, but it is a guide to action in nature and in protected areas. It is very important that they are respected as they are part of the experience.

Park's Capacity to receive visitors

Tagua-Tagua Park has a limited capacity to receive visitors at the same time. This is defined by the capacity of facilities and the fragility of the echo system, among other factors. For this and other reasons, people can visit the park only with previous bookings. Visitors without booking are not allowed.

Sleep in the park

The park only has capacity to receive 28 visitors per night. This is determined by the shelter's capacity. Alerces and Quetrus refuges are the only authorized places to overnight. Camping sites were not built due to its larger impact area. Shelters allow visitors to concentrate in one place.

Use of fire

Fire is one of the most sensitive issues to be touched when visiting protected areas as it is a major cause of forest loss. That's why within the park campfires are only enabled in the kitchen in each shelter. They are forbidden in unauthorized places.

Domestic animals

The park is characterized by having and protecting native flora and fauna. Many pets such as dogs and cats are carriers of diseases that can be transmitted to native species. Also, their hunter's instincts may impel them to attack nests, birds or other native species. Therefore it is not allowed to bring pets to the park.

Respect for others

People who come to the park do it for many different reasons, but all agree on at least one: the pursuit of tranquility that a place like this can provide. It is therefore very important to respect the hours of rest, avoiding annoying, or any other activity that disturbs the tranquility of the place.

Trash

This is as simple as explaining that we have no garbage collection service. For this reason, everything that people take to the park should be brought back. As we say, we do not stand for laws or regulations, but for principles, which we hope will be respected by all who visit the park.

Trails

The park's trails were strategically designed to minimize the impact on its land. This is one of the reasons why it is recommended not to leave them. Another reason is for self-care. Staying on the path will reduce risks at a maximum, avoiding disorientation, and loss of direction in the park.
